Directions for completing the Junior Achievement Scholarship Application

Essay must be double spaced, Arial or similar font with a font size 12.

Essay must be a minimum of 500 words but not exceed 600. Word count should be included at the bottom

Essay should cover the free enterprise system and how it has influenced you and/or your family.

Submit your essay as a pdf and do not include your name on the essay.

Please submit your essay on or before May 16, 2022.
