LAUREATE NOMINATION FORM

Each fall, **The Brazoria County Business Hall of Fame** will recognize the most esteemed leaders of the Brazoria County's free enterprise system. To be considered as a **Brazoria County Business Hall of Fame** *Laureate*, an individual's record of business achievement must demonstrate:

- a) business excellence
- b) courageous thinking and actions
- c) visionary and innovative leadership

- d) inspiring leadership
- e) community mindedness
- f) recognized by his/her org. for accomplishments

In addition, nominees must serve as a role model for those who follow. Stated more simply, **Brazoria County Business Hall of Fame** *Laureates* are individuals whose work has moved the <u>Brazoria County area</u> and society in general in a better, stronger direction.

Laureates will be selected from three broad categories:

- **→** Historical Laureates (deceased)
- > Contemporary/Active Laureates (individuals still engaged in the day-to-day activities of their businesses)
- > Contemporary/Retired Laureates (individuals who have retired from active business involvement)

The **Brazoria County Business Hall of Fame** review committee will strive for diversity among those selected as finalists; e.g., race, gender, industry, geography, size of business enterprise, etc.
